- **Reduce hiring costs.** Co-op students are paid hourly, a cost-effective flexible option.
- **Tailor co-op hiring to your needs.** Hire an undergraduate co-op student for four or six months, or a graduate student for up to eight months, or both! Students can work on long-term projects making significant contributions to your workplace.
- **Optimize staffing with flexible start terms.** With fall, spring, and summer start terms, you can hire different students for full-time coverage, and hire additional co-op students during peak periods.
- **Add or complement skillsets at all levels.** Select from students in over 60 engineering degree programs at the BS, MS, and PhD level.
- **Build your employee pipeline.** Identify student co-ops for upcoming full-time positions. More than 50% of students have received full-time job offers from a co-op employer after graduation.

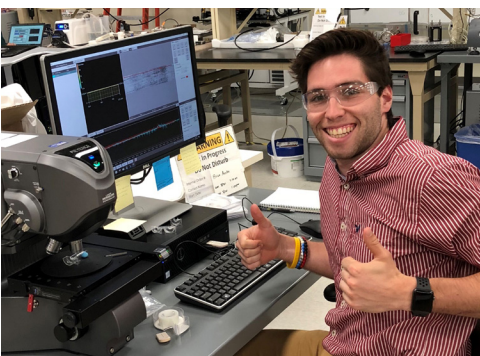
