What if my course is full?

Don't panic! Enrollments are always shifting as students get co-ops or change their course registrations. If a seat isn't available in your preferred classes, you can join the waitlist. To join a waitlist, enter the class CRN (the 5 numbers in parentheses next to the course number above) directly into your registration sheet and hit submit. You will then have an option to select "waitlist" from a drop-down menu. The waitlist system will automatically inform you when a seat opensjust log into your account and accept it within the 24-hour time limit!
